PERTINENT INFORMATION

ELIGIBILITY: Entries are open to female amateur golfers who have an up-to-date Handicap Index not exceeding 10.4 which has been established under a method approved by the USGA or R & A. Entries are subject to rejection at any time. In honor of the 80th Trans anniversary, 25+ age contestants may play in the Mid Amateur division. Players must declare if they are competing in the Amateur or the Mid Am. All players must conform to the USGA Rules of Amateur Status as defined in the Rules of Golf.

ENTRIES, FORMS AND FEES:

CONTESTANT FEE - \$155.00

NON-CONTESTANT FEE - \$35

ONLINE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED through our website, www.womenstrans.com. The process of entering online has changed. The Trans will be using PayPal as our official credit card processor. PayPal provides us improved security that is important to you and to the Trans. Follow the instructions detailed in the online process, OR entry forms may be printed from the TRANS website and posted in the US Postal Mail addressed to the Entry Director along with a check or money order made payable to WTNGA. Email addresses are essential in order to resolve any issues with the applications and for notification of receipt/acceptance. Entry Applicants will receive notification of acceptance on or before June 11, 2010. On June 11, 2010 at 5 p.m. EDT, all entry applications received will be accepted in handicap index order. Entry applications will continue to be accepted beyond this date if the field is not full; a maximum of 108 Amateur and 21 Mid Am players will be accepted; however, the Tournament Committee reserves the right to determine the number of players in each division.

Accepted entries may receive a refund of fees if cancellations are made prior to July 5, 2010. After this date, fees will be refunded in the event of injury or illness if requested by July 12, 2010 and accompanied by a doctor's report. No refund for any reason after July 12, 2010. A \$25 service charge will be deducted from all refunds.

NOTIFICATION: An email or postal mail will be sent acknowledging the receipt of all entry applications. On June 11, 2010, the field of 108 Amateur and 21 Mid Am players will be accepted based on the lowest handicap index entries received to that point. All other applicants will be placed on 'standby' in order of handicap index and will be notified of their status. Later entries will be accepted and either added to the 'standby' list or entered in the championship if the field is not full.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT: The field will be comprised of 129 contestants: 108 Amateur and 21 Mid Am Division. The Championship is contested at match play with a 36-hole stroke play qualifier to determine positions for match play and Medalist honors. The low 64 Am players and the low 16 Mid Am players will qualify for match play.

TOURNAMENT TRANSPORTATION: Players and caddies must walk at all times during a stipulated round. The optional condition prescribed in Appendix I of the Rules of Golf will be in effect. Anyone (player or caddie) seeking a golf cart due to a disability as defined under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) should log onto www.womenstrans.com or contact the Entry Director, Tina Sanders, to obtain information on procedures for submitting such requests. All requests with required information must be submitted to the TRANS simultaneously and together with the original entry application in writing, and received by the TRANS Entry Director no later than 5 p.m. EDT, June 11, 2010. Facsimile, phone or online submissions FOR THIS REQUEST FOR CART not accepted. Requests due to temporary injuries or impairments that do not qualify as a "disability" under the ADA will not be granted. Carts for caddies or the players available only for those who are ADA-qualified.

CADDIES: A player may carry her own bag, bring her own caddie or pull cart; pull carts are available at The Country Club of Lincoln (CCL), or request a host club caddie. There will be a limited number of host club caddies available. CADDIES MUST BE REQUESTED ON THE ENTRY APPLICATION. The contestant will be obligated to two rounds if hiring a club caddie. The caddie fee is \$50.00 minimum per round, plus gratuity.

PRACTICE ROUND/S: The official practice round is scheduled on Sunday, July 25; tee times will be available from 9:30 a.m. - 2:00 p.m. You may have a second free practice round on Saturday afternoon by playing in the 1:30 p.m. Co-Am event. You may purchase an additional practice round at a rate of \$25, plus tax. To schedule your practice round/s, call CCL Pro Shop (402) 423-2271 beginning July 11, 2010. To register for the Saturday Co-Am event, please check the correct box under SPECIAL EVENTS on the application form.

PUBLICITY, PROMOTION and BROADCASTING: The TRANS may arrange for promotion of this Championship for radio, television, broadcasting and other exhibition and publication of this Championship, including the TRANS Website. By this application, the player or the legal guardian for a junior player consents to the use by the TRANS, or persons authorized by the TRANS of her name, likeness, voice and references to her and photographs and other images of her and her play connected with her appearance in this Championship or any portion(s) thereof, in connection with such media promotion, broadcasting and other exhibition and publication of this Championship.

REGISTRATION: All players must register in person at CCL, Saturday, July 24 between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. **OR** Sunday, July 25 between 8 a.m. and 12 p.m. **OR** notify the Entry Director by phone or letter of arrival time and intention to play. Place may be forfeited by a player from whom no response is received by 12 p.m. on Sunday, July 25, 2010. A mandatory fee of \$35.00 will be collected at Registration from all players for range balls, club cleaning and gratuities. Also, non-contestant fees will be collected at Registration for any player's guest(s) who wish to attend the social functions.
