FOUR-BALL CHAMPIONSHIP PERTINENT INFORMATION

ELIGIBILITY: Entries are open to female amateur golfers who have reached their 50th birthday on or before April 24, 2018 and have a maximum handicap index of 30. Both partners, including foreign contestants, must meet all eligibility requirements. Entries are subject to rejection at anytime.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT: Format will be 54-hole four-ball stroke play (Rule 31) in which two competitors play as partners, each playing her own ball. The lower score of the partners is the score for the hole. Each day will consist of an 18 hole round. All teams will qualify for flights based on their 36 hole total score. The committee will determine the number of teams per flight after qualifying rounds.

ENTRIES, FORM AND FEES:

Entry Fee \$360 per player/\$720 per team includes:

- Golf and Shared Cart Monday through Thursday
- Driving Range Usage and Range Balls
- Complimentary Club Storage
- Welcome Reception
- Awards Luncheon on Thursday

Online entries will be accepted thru our website: www.womenstrans.com beginning Monday, January 1 at 2 PM CST. Online processing requires a credit card; PayPal is our official credit card processor. Email addresses are required. An email will be sent acknowledging the receipt of ALL entry applications.

Entries MUST be submitted as a team with all information provided for both players. The players may choose to pay individually or as a team and must indicate payment preference on the entry form.

56 Teams will be accepted as they arrive by date of entry.

NOTIFICATION: Notice of acceptance to all teams will be made immediately upon payment. Entries not accepted will be placed on a wait list established in the order of entry receipt and cancellations will be filled from the wait list. Late entries will be added to the wait list or entered in the championship if the field is not full.

A player may substitute a partner at any time prior to April 24, 2018, provided the substituted player meets all eligibility requirements. Accepted entries may receive a refund of fees if cancellations are made prior to April 10, 2018. After this date, refunds will only be made for injury or illness that has been certified by a doctor's written report and which has been approved for refund by the Board. A \$25 service charge will be deducted from each player's refund.

PRACTICE ROUNDS: The official practice round is scheduled on Monday, April 23, 2018. There will be a few tee times available for players wishing to play their practice round on Sunday afternoon. Practice rounds may be obtained by calling (520.398.2021) for a tee time 30 days in advance. Additional Practice Rounds will be available for \$65. Practice round scorecards will be available online or in the pro shop prior to the Championship.

FYI: Contestants are reminded that Tubac allows soft spikes only. Proper golf attire is required. The Golf Shop will open at 6:00 AM; the driving range will open at 6:00 AM. A stationary drink cart will be located at Otero #5 for drink and snack purchases.

PRIZES AND AWARDS: The low gross team will be presented THE WILMA CUP perpetual trophy to remain in their possession for one year. The CUP is actually two beautiful antique silver vases donated in honor of Wilma Gilliland in recognition of her many years of dedicated support and commitment to Women's Trans National Golf Association.

The low gross team after 36 holes of qualifying will receive the LUCILE ROBINSON MANN perpetual award donated by the WTNGA 1941 Champion, Lucile Mann. This lovely sterling silver tray was presented to Mrs. Mann by the Women's Trans National Golf Association in honor of her victory. First, second and third low gross teams in each flight will receive a prize.

PUBLICITY, PROMOTION and BROADCASTING: The WTNGA may arrange for promotion of this Championship for radio, television, broadcasting and other exhibition and publication of this Championship, including the WTNGA Website. By this application, the player consents to the use by the WTNGA, or persons authorized by the WTNGA of her name, likeness, voice and references to her and photographs and other images of her and her play connected with her appearance in this Championship or any portion/s thereof, in connection with such media promotion, broadcasting and other exhibition and publication of this Championship.

REGISTRATION: (All times are Mountain Standard Times (MST).) All players must register in person on Monday,

April 23 between 8 AM and 2 PM MST or notify the Four-Ball Entry Director, Tina Sanders, by phone (865.705.3333) or letter of arrival time and intention to play. Place may be forfeited if a response is not received by 2 PM MST on April 23, 2018.

Non-contestant fees will be collected at Registration for any player's guest/s who wish to attend the social functions. (Non-Contestant Player Reception fee - \$26; Non-Contestant Awards Luncheon fee - \$21)

TRANSPORTATION: All major airlines and rental cars are available at the Tucson or Phoenix airport. Tucson is approximately 45 minutes from Tubac; Phoenix is approximately 2 1/2 hours from Tubac.
