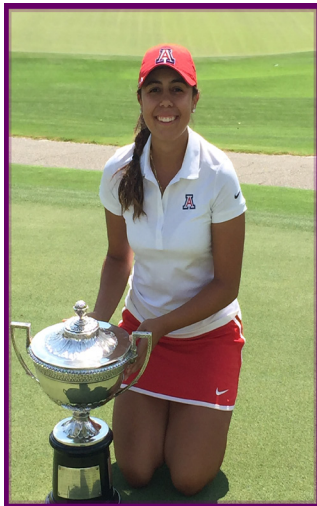

## AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP PERTINENT INFORMATION

**ELIGIBILITY** Entries are open to female amateur golfers who have a current Handicap Index not exceeding 10.4 which has been established under a method approved by the USGA or R & A. Entries are subject to rejection at any time. All players must conform to the USGA Rules of Amateur Status as defined in the Rules of Golf.

**CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT** An official practice round for contestants is scheduled on the day immediately preceding the first round of competition. The Championship format is a 72 hole stroke play competition. After 36 holes of play, the field will be cut to the lowest 60 scores and ties if the field is greater than 72 players.

**AWARDS CEREMONIES** After 36 holes of play, presentation of the Amateur, Junior, Mid-Amateur and Senior Medalists and Team awards will take place at the scoreboard area.

Immediately following the final round, awards will be presented in the Main Dining Room to the Top 10 Finalists including the Amateur Runner-up and the Amateur CHAMPION.

The Publicity Director will be taking photos of the winners for the 2019 WTNGA annual.

### **ENTRIES, FORMS AND FEES**

**CONTESTANT FEE - \$240.00**

Online entries will be available January 1, 2018 at 2 PM CST on the WTNGA website: [www.womenstrans.com](http://www.womenstrans.com). PayPal is our official credit card processor. E-mail addresses are required. An e-mail will be sent acknowledging the receipt of all entry applications. 120 players will be accepted based on the handicap index requirements and entry fee payment. Acceptance notification will be sent to the player and added to the list of accepted players on the website. If the field is full, entry applications received will be placed on a 'standby' list by handicap index order and a notification will be sent to the player.

Accepted entries may receive a refund of fees if cancellations are made prior to June 18, 2018. After this date, a request for a refund due to injury or illness must be accompanied by a doctor's report. This request must be made by July 4, 2018 and will be reviewed by the board. All refunds are subject to a \$25 administrative fee.

**TRANSPORTATION** Automotive Transportation is prohibited during a stipulated round. Any player or caddie seeking a golf cart due to a disability as defined under the Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA) should log onto the Amateur page on the Website: [www.womenstrans.com](http://www.womenstrans.com). Click on the ADA Forms link on the left to download the forms. Requests with complete required information must be submitted to the Amateur Entry Director simultaneously and together with the original entry application in writing, and received by the Entry Director no later than 5 PM EDT on Tuesday, May 23, 2018. Facsimile, phone or online submissions not accepted. Requests due to temporary injuries or impairments that do not qualify as a permanent disability under the ADA will not be granted. In the event of a change in medical condition subsequent to submission of entry application, written submission of all documentation must be received by the Entry Director no later than seven (7) days before event. Carts for caddies or players during the championship are available only for those who are ADA-qualified and who have complied with the above procedure.

**FYI** All times are Pacific Daylight Time (PDT). The WTNGA/Media room will be located in the Fiesta Room. Players' message board will be located outside the Ladies Locker Room by the Pro Shop. Cash, checks major credit cards may be used for on-site purchases. Contestants are reminded that soft spikes are mandatory and proper golf attire is required.

**CADDIES** A player may carry her own bag, use a pull cart, bring a caddie, or request a host club caddie. The host club will make every effort to provide sufficient caddies for the Championship but **CADDIES MUST BE REQUESTED ON THE ENTRY APPLICATION**. Contestant will be obligated to two rounds if hiring a club caddie. The caddie fee is \$50.00 minimum per round, plus gratuity.

**PRACTICE ROUND/S** The official practice round is scheduled on Monday, July 9; tee times will be available beginning at 7:30 AM. An additional practice round may be arranged for Sunday, July 8, beginning at 12 PM at a cost of \$45 (walk) or \$59 (cart). To schedule practice round/s, call Peach Tree Country Club Pro Shop (530) 743-2039 beginning June 24, 2018 and identify yourself as a WTNGA player.

**PUBLICITY, PROMOTION and BROADCASTING** The WTNGA may arrange for promotion of this Championship for radio, television, broadcasting and other exhibition and publication of this Championship, including the WTNGA Annual and Website. By this application, the player or the legal guardian for a junior player consents to the use by the WTNGA, or persons authorized by the WTNGA, of her name, likeness, voice and references to her and photographs and other images of her and her play connected with her appearance in this Championship or any portion/s thereof, in connection with such media promotion, broadcasting and other exhibition and publication of this Championship.

**WORLD AMATEUR GOLF RANKING (WAGR™)** coverage includes more than 10,000 players from 102 countries, and more than 4,000 ranking tournaments played in 104 countries. The WTNGA forwards all information from our Amateur Championship to the WAGR™ for inclusion in their ranking system.

**REGISTRATION** All players must register in person in the Vista Room on Sunday, July 9 between 12 PM and 4 PM or Monday, July 10 between 7:30 AM and 12 PM or notify the Amateur Entry Director by phone or letter of arrival time and intention to play. Place may be forfeited by a player from whom no response is received by 12 PM on Monday, July 9, 2018. A fee of \$30 will be collected at Registration for any player's guest/s who wish to attend the players' welcome pairings party.
